

Reset Program Student Expectations

Initial next to each statement below to show you understand and will comply with the following student expectations for the Reset Program:

_____ I will arrive at Butler Educational Center **no earlier than 7:20** and no later than 7:50 a.m. If I am riding the school bus, the arrival time is dependent on the bus route. Dismissal starts at 1:30 p.m.

_____ When I arrive at Butler, I will be in a **complete school uniform**. In addition, students at the Butler campus are **not allowed to wear Crocs**, house shoes, slides, etc.... If my shorts seem too short (as per Reset staff), I will have to change. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings and no student is allowed to wear a nose piercing. **Hoodies are also not allowed.**

_____ If I show up out of uniform, I will wait in the office until I can get a change of clothes. **Any delay in getting to the classroom may result in another day at Reset.**

_____ **I will not bring a backpack or any bags.** I may bring my ELA workbook, a folder, AR book, or other papers that I am currently working on in class. If I bring a phone, it will be taken up and returned to me at the end of the day.

_____ I will work on my classwork assignments for that day, followed by any missing or incomplete assignments, followed by any make-up work that my teachers assign. If for some reason, all of my assigned work from all classes is complete, I am to check with the Reset teachers for assignments to assist in any areas or skills I need help with. If I complete that work, I can ask to check with the Reset Behavior Interventionist for any assistance with my behavior.

_____ While I am in Reset, I am not allowed to go to any school or afterschool functions (including band and sports) except to ride the bus. The Reset program is an alternative to a suspension, but **suspension rules still apply.**

_____ I must complete **5 good days** at Reset (as determined by attendance, behavior, and completion of classwork). If I have issues in any of these areas, the Reset facilitator, in consultation with Reset teachers and the Behavior Interventionist, will decide if I need to make up that day. This includes if I miss time due to a scheduled appointment or any other reason.
