School Improvement Plan Implementation Timeline

Here is our timeline for attaining the goals outlined in our school's improvement plan.

Timeframe	Activity
Fall 2021	Use Dibels, Daze, IRLA and math diagnostic to determine current student proficiency levels . Use Tier I Curriculum and intervention to deliver high quality instruction to all students. Additional ActivPanels and Red Cat Systems added to classrooms.
Winter 2022	Continue using high quality Tier I curriculum and interventions to move students to grade level.
Spring 2022	Host a school wide steam night (if allowed due to COVID). Use Tier I Curriculum and intervention to deliver high quality instruction to all students.
