

Parkway High School 2022-23 Dress Code Updates

- Pants/Shorts/Skirts

1. Black or Khaki color only
2. No Nylon, Mesh, or Swim Style shorts.
3. Minimum 4 inch inseam on shorts.
4. No tights, leggings, or joggers.

- Spirit Shirts

1. Parkway themed spirit shirts will be allowed to be worn everyday as long as the shirt is in **Parkway colors**.
2. We are no longer wearing shirts that were given in sports tournaments, competitions, etc. that are not in our Parkway school colors as everyday spirit shirts.
3. **Everyday spirit shirts not issued through the school store will phase out in a 2 year window.** Beginning with the 24-25 school year students will only be allowed to wear school store purchased everyday shirts.

- Hoodies/outerwear

1. Solid in color. (no multiple color non Parkway outwear, even if it is in school colors)
2. No oversized logos. (no Champion, Nike, Sports teams, etc.)
3. **HOODS ARE NEVER TO BE WORN ON A STUDENT'S HEAD IN THE BUILDING. THIS INCLUDES IN THE CLASSROOM.**
4. **Hoodies not issued through the school store will phase out in a 2 year window.** Beginning with the 24-25 school year students will only be allowed to wear hoodies purchased through the school store.

- Hair Color

1. Must be consistent with natural Hair colors and limited to black, brown, blond, or red. All other colors are exempt.
2. This includes extensions, weave, braids, etc. This also includes streaks and highlights.

- Shoes/Accessories

1. No Slides of any kind (including yeezy slides). Crocs are allowed.
2. No houseshoes, slippers, flip flops, or furry-flops.
3. No Sunglasses.
4. No excessive make-up.
5. No spiked accessories.
6. No garters.
7. Nose piercing should be studded and not looped in any way.
8. Stockings should be solid black or white. (not fishnet style stockings)

- Cell Phones

1. Cell Phones/Smart Watches are to be put away during instructional time. This should happen before the tardy bell rings. These devices can be placed in backpacks or in designated locations as determined by the classroom teacher. These devices should not be on your person during instructional time.
2. Bathroom breaks during instructional time are cell phone exempt times as well. Cell phones should not go to the restroom with students during instructional time.
3. Airpods/Headphones may no longer be used during transitions. (safety hazard).
4. Cell phones may be accessed during extended break periods (morning arrival/lunch).
5. Posting videos, pictures, or messages during the school day is prohibited. Students found guilty of posting of any kind will lose cell phone privileges for the remainder of the school year.

STUDENTS WILL BE ON A THREE STRIKE SYSTEM WITH REGARD TO DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS.

STRIKE 1=STUDENT WARNING

STRIKE 2=PARENTAL CONTACT AND LOSS OF PRIVILEGE FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME AS DESIGNATED BY ADMINISTRATION.

**STRIKE 3=PARENTAL CONTACT AND LOSS OF PRIVILEGE FOR THE
REMAINDER OF THE YEAR.**
